



Centre County Recycling & Refuse Authority Electronics Recycling Guide

Beginning January 3, 2012, “Covered Devices” will only be accepted for recycling. Residents should bring their covered devices to the **Authority’s Electronic Recycling Drop-Off Location**, which is located next to the Transfer Station. On and after this date, electronics will no longer be accepted as trash.

Before Governor Rendell left office, he signed Act 108 of 2010 (The Covered Device Recycling Act), which bans all covered devices from landfills effective January 23, 2013. The Centre County Recycling & Refuse Authority has taken a proactive stance to the law and has banned covered devices from our Transfer Station effective the 3rd of January, 2012.

What are “Covered Devices?” The term covered devices includes desktop computers, monitors, laptops, computer peripherals and televisions. However, we will accept many other electronic devices for recycling.

A partial list is shown below.

The Recycling & Refuse Authority is located at 253 Transfer Road, in Bellefonte. We are located in between the Nittany Mall and Rockview Prison, off of Route 26. To recycle your electronics, follow the signs to the Scales (Gate 1), and tell our Scale Operator what you have. They will direct you to the drop-off location. We are open Monday - Saturday from 8 am - 4 pm. This is a free service.
